WHY GO? Mission trips can be a great personal journey as well as vital to the success of the ministry. It is an opportunity to develop new skills and perspectives by working alongside our Haitian partners to help encourage and strengthen their community.

WHEN IS THE TRIP? Spring 2020 – exact date to be determined by the team!

WHO DO WE WORK WITH? We partner with Haiti Outreach Ministries (HOM), a North American NGO, and the Mission of the Christian Church of Cite Soleil (MICECC), a group of Haitian leaders. Together they have been ministering to the people of Haiti since 1989 through evangelism, education and health care. They welcome teams organized by churches and civic groups to serve in one of the many ministries developed to meet the needs of the Haitian people.

WHERE DO WE GO? Haiti is just a few hours away from Miami (by plane). HOM/MICECC's campuses are located in Cite Soleil, one of the poorest communities in Port Au Prince. The team will stay at the HOM Guesthouse on the Terre Noire campus or a local hotel close to the campuses.

WHAT IS THE COST? Approximately \$1400 - \$1600 per person, depending on number of team members, airfare and lodging choice.

WHICH MISSION PROJECT WOULD WE DO? Although there are many needs, we are recruiting for a medical mission and construction. For the Medical we need – MDs, NPs, PAs, RNs, Pharmacists are needed. EMTs, Paramedics, CNAs, labs tech and other medical personnel are welcome. Non-medical people can also serve as helpers – For Construction, if you can hold a paint brush, we can use you! if you are willing, we can find a way to put your gift to work.

WHAT ABOUT SAFETY? Working in our communities with our ministries is usually safe. Our partners in Haiti will not allow us to travel if there is any concerns regarding the safety and well-being of our teams.
