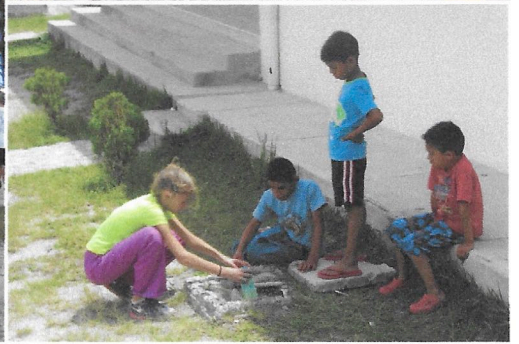
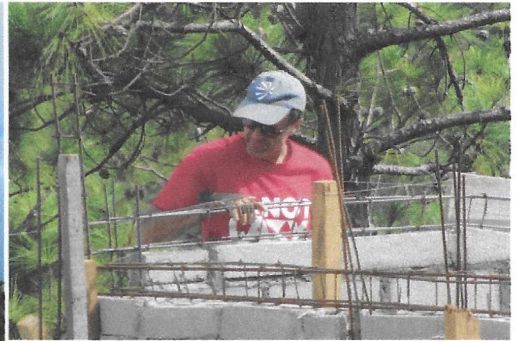


# Summer Mission Trip The Lamb Institute

**LAMB Institute / Tegucigalpa, Honduras**  
**July 29 – Aug 5, 2023**

**Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. Hebrews 10:24**

THE LAMB INSTITUTE LAMB Institute is a Christ-centered, multifaceted ministry based in Tegucigalpa, Honduras that seeks to reach out to the world with the love of Jesus. LAMB operates an elementary school in one of the most poverty-stricken areas of Tegucigalpa, a residential home for over 60 children suffering abandonment, neglect, abuse – the product of a nation in extreme poverty. Other ministries include The Transition Program giving future hope for children of LAMB reaching the age of 18, a Daycare in Flore del Campo, Joy Christian Academy and Youth in Action, formerly The Alonzo Movement, a large outreach and gang prevention program for inner-city youth. Our team will be working outside the city at the residential children's home providing construction assistance, coordinating activities for the children and serving in any other way that LAMB and the Lord call us.

- **Trip Dates** July 29- Aug 5th, 2023 (Saturday-Saturday)
- **Cost** Approximately \$850 per person, plus your airline tickets (airport code XLP)  
The cost of the trip includes lodging and meals. Airfare is purchased separately by each individual team member. Your only additional cost would be spending money for shopping and meals in the airport. Groups may additionally decide to take items with them to entertain the children. This can be paid for by collection or fund raising.
- **How do I enroll?**  
Due to the popularity of the LAMB mission trip we will begin taking applications on September 13th. To enroll and secure your spot on the team you must both complete the online application and pay a \$250 deposit. The mission trip application can be found <https://mppc.net/mission-trip-application/>. Once you have completed the application, please bring a check made out to MPPC for \$250 in an envelope clearly marked "LAMB Trip Deposit" and place it in Glenn Hair's mailbox at the church. You can pay online when applying, but there is a 4% fee charged.
- **Fundraising**  
We will provide a sample letter to use for individual fund raising and encourage team members to write letters to friends and family to solicit funds for your trip. The MPPC International Missions Team offers a scholarship opportunity for mission trips that you are more than welcome to apply for at <https://mppc.net/scholarship-application/>.
- **Immunizations/Covid (More details will be reviewed in the first team meeting.)**  
Covid – currently to enter Honduras, you must have a hard copy negative **COVID-19** (PCR, RAT, or Elisa) test taken 72 hours (3 days) before travel. Covid protocols will be communicated as they update/change.  
Tetanus and all other routine immunization (verify with documentation)  
Hepatitis A and Typhoid (strongly recommended)  
Malaria (not required – up to individual judgment)
- **Where do we stay?**  
Casa LAMB is LAMB's guest house in Tegucigalpa (about 30 minutes from the children's residential home). LAMB Volunteer Coordinator, Letty McCall, will be at Casa LAMB and stays with the group for the entire duration of the trip. Precautions are taken so the water and food are safe to consume at Casa LAMB.
- **What will we be doing?**  
At this time, our team project is not determined as we are open and willing to serve where we are most needed. We may or may not know our project before we depart, but we will be prepared for anything.
- **Safety**  
The safety of our team is the utmost priority of both the MPPC and LAMB teams. Team members are expected to respectfully adhere to all rules and guidelines to ensure the safety of everyone. While in Honduras, LAMB Volunteer Coordinator Amanda Scott travels with the group at all times acting as a guide, translator and friend.

This will be a great trip! You can expect to grow closer to the Lord and closer to your MPPC community. You can expect to play lots of futbol (soccer) and to fall in love with the children of LAMB. You can expect to work hard and have a lot of fun!
