- Mission partner liaisons were excited to report back to their mission partners about the increased support made possible by our mission's budget increase this year. They will be looking for ways to share with the congregation about the impact this support is making.

- MPPC participated in the Walk for Water on March 21 with 21 people signed up.
- MPPC will be stocking the Blessing Box at the Presbytery Office in April.
- The Charleston Area Justice Ministry (CAJM) is the mission focus for April. CAJM's Nehemiah Action Assembly will be held on April 27.

Personnel

- The Learning Center has contracted with InBalance Business Solutions to take over the responsibilities previously managed by Joanne Westbury.
- A committee, chaired by Mac Thigpen, has been established to interview candidates and assist in hiring a part-time bookkeeper for the church.
